Alongside these resources, is a book written by Hazel Biggs that highlights information about the decades from pre 1829 to 1890.

*Tour Through Time* resources were created by teachers and include comprehensive teaching programs for primary and secondary students. With WA history and heritage as the central theme, activities integrate across a number of learning areas.

To allow flexibility in catering for individual needs and preferences, the teaching programs contain an extensive range of activities. The ideas and activities provide sound learning experiences presented in a fun and enjoyable way.

### Primary School Resources

The Resource Books provide teachers' programs and photo-copiable worksheets for students in the early to middle childhood phases. An integrated approach has been adopted and a wide range of areas within the curriculum has been covered including Art, English, Health, Mathematics, Science, and Society and Environment. *Tour Through Time Pre 1829 to 1890s*, written by Hazel Biggs, covers the period of the series and compliments these materials.

### **Secondary School Resources**

Each CD has over 100 pages of investigative materials with a wealth of primary and secondary sources and in-class activities appropriate for students in the adolescent and late adolescent phases of learning. In addition a 30 page Teacher Resource Book is included as well as on-site materials for a visit to the relevant property.
